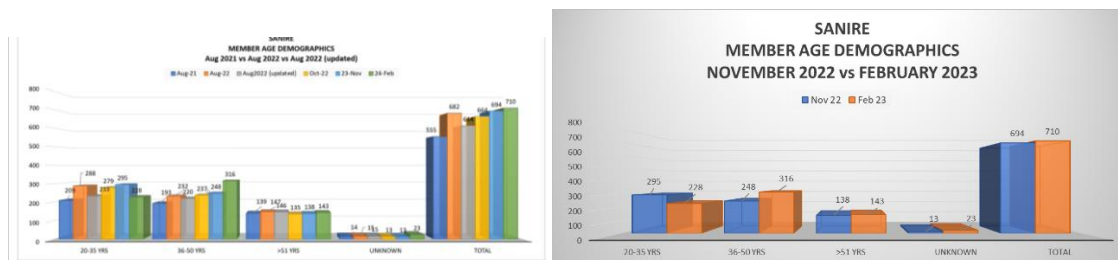

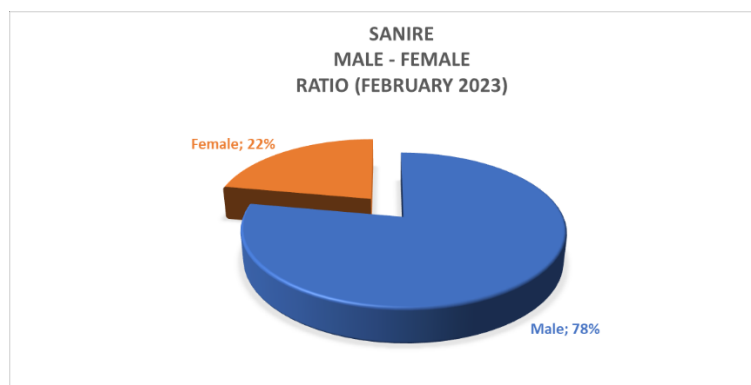


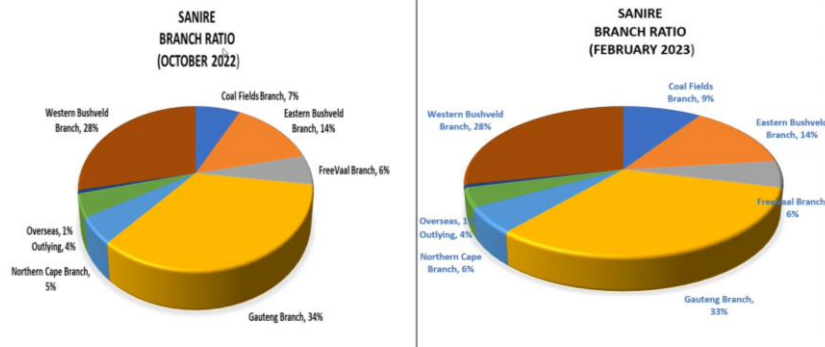

Member Fee Recovery

Membership Subscriptions Fee Outstanding

- Mr. S. Mashile reported that the letters will be issued in the next week to all outstanding debtors reminding members of their outstanding fees and that if there is any arrangement with their organization, a consolidated invoice has been forwarded to the organization for payment but the invoice to member is for their records only.

Outstanding Membership Termination Letter

- It was noted that at the end of April, a letter of termination will be issued to all outstanding debtors.
- SANIRE's constitution extract point 7.4 was emphasized regarding members not in good standing procedure:

7. FEES, SUBSCRIPTIONS AND OTHER INCOME

7.1 Entrance fees (if applicable) and subscriptions are annually decided by the council. A list of entrance fees and subscriptions will be placed on the SANIRE communication platforms and members will be kept advised of any changes made.

7.3 All subscriptions become due on the first day of July in each year and are payable in advance.

7.4 A member whose annual subscription is unpaid after 31 December in any year ceases to be in good standing and is not entitled to receive the notices, publications or awards of the Institute, nor to exercise any of the rights and privileges of membership.

7.4.1 A member whose annual subscription remains unpaid for one year may, by resolution of the council, be excluded from the Institute. He/she thereupon ceases to be a member and his/her name will be removed from the membership register. Notice to this effect will be sent to him/her in writing by the administrator at his/her last registered address and/or e-mail address, three months before the termination of the stated period.

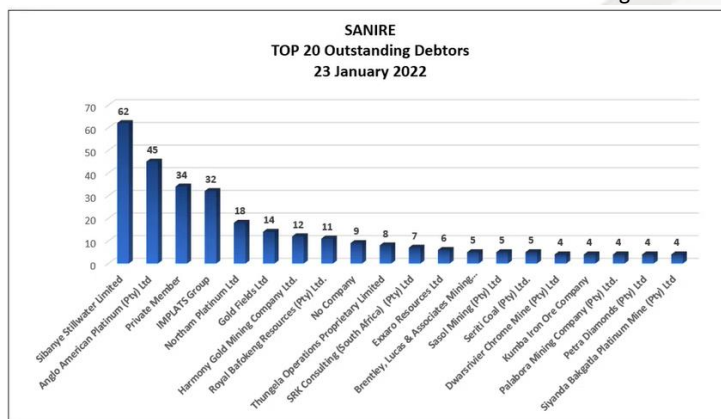
7.4.2 Such exclusion does not relieve him/her from liability for the payment of any moneys due by him/her; any person whose membership has so ceased may at the discretion of the council and upon payment of all fees due, be reinstated within one year from the date of the resolution of the council excluding him/her. Thereafter, he/she may be re-admitted only on such conditions as the council may decide.

	<u>Theory Examinations</u> General - Proposed examination dates: ❖ 08 – 11 May 2023 ❖ 09 – 12 October 2023 - Minerals Council meeting took place on the 20th February 2023: Examinations Guidelines for Examiners and Moderators. ❖ 40% attendance. ❖ Proposed agreement between Minerals Council and Examiners/ Moderators. - SANIRE & Minerals Council meeting on the examinations and security took place on the 1st March 2022 and the following feedback in terms of safeguarding the exams: 1. A tamper-proof envelope will be used going forward to seal the examinations papers. 2. Examination papers will be sent in their tamper-proof envelopes from the office of the Minerals Council. 3. The Minerals Council will randomly select two to four candidates who will be writing exams on any particular day. - o The invigilators will need to identify at least two of these candidates and in their presence will the envelopes be opened. - o These names will be communicated to the two invigilators on the day of the exam. The same process will be followed for sealing scripts after the exam. 4. A photo of a sealed-tamper envelope should be available at every exam centre to indicate to the invigilators and preselected candidates what a sealed envelope should look like. 5. A “Service Level Agreement” between the Minerals Council, examiners and moderators should be drafted containing the subject matter as discussed during a Teams meeting held on 20 February 2023. - o This document will be forwarded to the SANIRE Education Portfolio Holder, SANIRE President and SANIRE Vice-President for comments before being enacted. 6.
